



The director of Lantania Water, Pedro Almagro, joins IDRA's Board of Directors

Created in 1973, IDRA is a non-profit association with members in over 60 countries and more than 15 affiliated organisations.

The director of Lantania Water will officially take on his role at the association on 12 December 2024, following the conclusion of the IDRA World Congress in Abu Dhabi.

Almagro has been part of Lantania since late 2021, when he joined the Group as Director of Desalination to become head of the Water division a year later. An Industrial Technical Engineer by profession, he has focused his professional career on the water sector, occupying various important positions at international level, leading the development of markets such as China and the United States.
